



2007 ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

In a nutshell the following will apply this year:

1. Should your team be involved in a violent incident that leads to the abandonment of the game the matter will come before the Disciplinary Committee. Should the Disciplinary Committee find your team guilty of participating in violence that led to the abandonment of a game your team will be suspended from the competition for the balance of the season.
2. Should spectators associated with your team invade the pitch or cause any disturbance that leads to the abandonment of the game a hearing will be conducted by the Disciplinary Committee. Should the Disciplinary Committee find that it was your spectators that caused the incident that led to the abandonment of the game then your team will be suspended from the competition for the balance of the season.

The Association will not tolerate violence or improper conduct by players or spectators any longer. We have had record numbers of registrations for the fourth consecutive year. We will be conducting the largest competition ever administered by the Association. We wish to conduct that competition within our various codes of conduct and I recommend to you that you consult the CDSFA website to acquaint yourself with those codes of conduct.

It is our objective to ensure players enjoy their football in a safe environment free of abuse and violence. I seek your help and support in meeting this objective.
